

Disposal of Feminine Hygiene Products

DISPOSAL



1. Preparation:

- After use, wrap the used product (e.g., pad or tampon) in its original wrapper, toilet paper, or tissue to contain odors and prevent leaks.



2. Use of Sanitary Bins:

- Place the wrapped product in the designated sanitary disposal bin.
- Do not flush feminine hygiene products, wrappers, or other non-flushable items down the toilet.
- If using a menstrual cup, dispose of any tissues used for cleaning in the sanitary bin.



3. Hand Hygiene:

- Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer immediately after disposal.

MAINTENANCE OF SANITARY BINS BY CUSTODIAL STAFF



1. Regular Inspection:

- Check bins at least once per day or more frequently in high-traffic areas to ensure they are not overflowing.



2. Replacing Liners:

- Wear disposable gloves before handling waste.
- Remove the liner bag carefully, ensuring no spills.
- Tie the liner securely and place it in the appropriate waste container (e.g., general waste or sanitary waste collection).



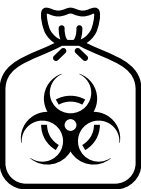
3. Cleaning and Sanitizing:

- Clean and sanitize the bin thoroughly after removing waste and before placing a new liner.
- Use approved disinfectants and follow manufacturer's instructions.

4. Restocking Supplies:

- Ensure a new liner is placed in the bin.
- Restock any additional restroom supplies, such as wrappers or tissues.

WASTE DISPOSAL MANAGEMENT



1. Segregation:

- Ensure feminine hygiene waste is separated from recyclable or biodegradable waste.

2. Waste Collection:

- Place collected waste in designated sanitary waste collection containers for proper disposal.
- Coordinate with waste management services for regular pick-up and disposal.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



- **Gloves Use:** Custodial staff must wear disposable gloves when handling sanitary waste.
