BLUE : GENERAL CLEANING

- > General Cleaning
- > Floors
- > Walls
- > Mirrors & Glass
- > Computer Screens / Electronics

RED : HIGH-GERM RISK SURFACES

- > Rest Room Cleaning & Floors
- > Toilets
- > Urinals
- > Bathroom Partitions

YELLOW : FIXTURES, TOUCH SURFACES

- > Special Project Cleaning
- > Sinks
- > Faucets
- > Hand Dryers
- > Towel & Soap Dispensers

GREEN : FOOD SERVICE

- > Dining Tables & Chairs
- > Food Prep Areas
- > Dish Washing
- > Food Vending Areas

WHITE : SPECIAL APPLICATIONS

- > Floor Finish
- > Bar Tops & Counters
- > Kitchen
- > General Use

BLUE : DUSTER KIT

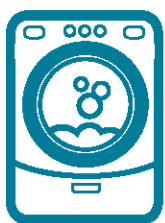
- > Overhead Dusting
- > Flat Surface Dusting
- > Vents, Fans & Blinds

Microfiber Washing Instructions



FABRIC SOFTENER

- > Never use fabric softener
- > Fabric softener will clog and ruin yarn



WASHING

- > Maximum Washing Temp. 194F/90C
- > Do Not Use Strong Alkaline Detergent
- > Normal Agitation Cycle
- > Normal Rinse Cycle



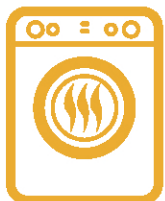
BLEACHING

- > Periodic Light Bleach Only
- > Oxygen Bleach Approved
- > Liquid Bleach In Moderation



SPINNING

- > Unlike Cotton, Microfiber Does Not Absorb Water
- > Water Is Stored In The Cells Of The Yarn
- > Centrifugal Spinning Will Remove 95% Moisture
- > Extended Spin Cycle Will Reduce Dryer Time



DRYING

- > Maximum Drying Temp. 140F/60C
- > Tumble Dry At Low Temperature
- > Avoid Over Drying
- > Extreme Temperature Will Ruin Yarn
- > Less Dry Time Will Extend Life
